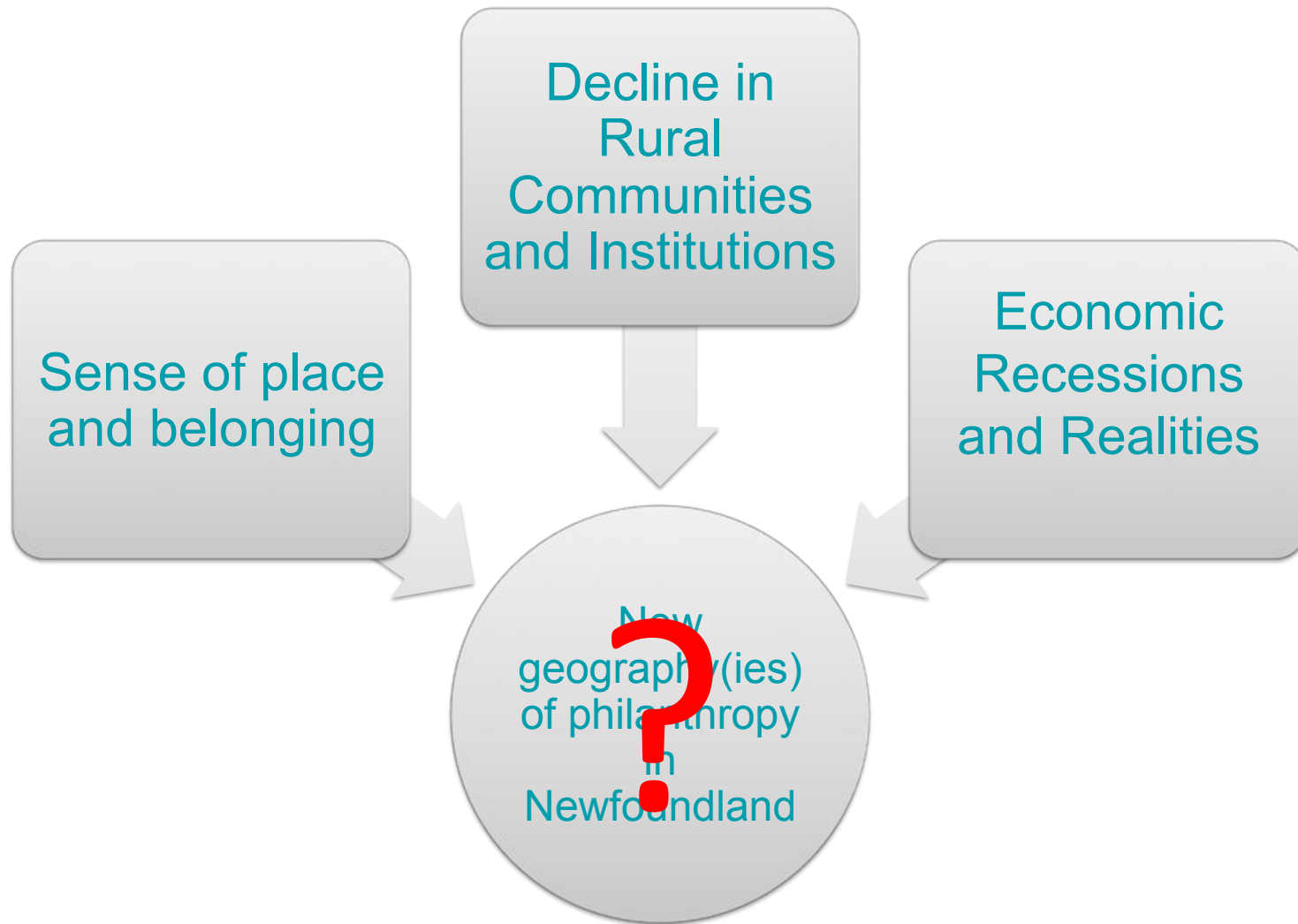

- Out migration

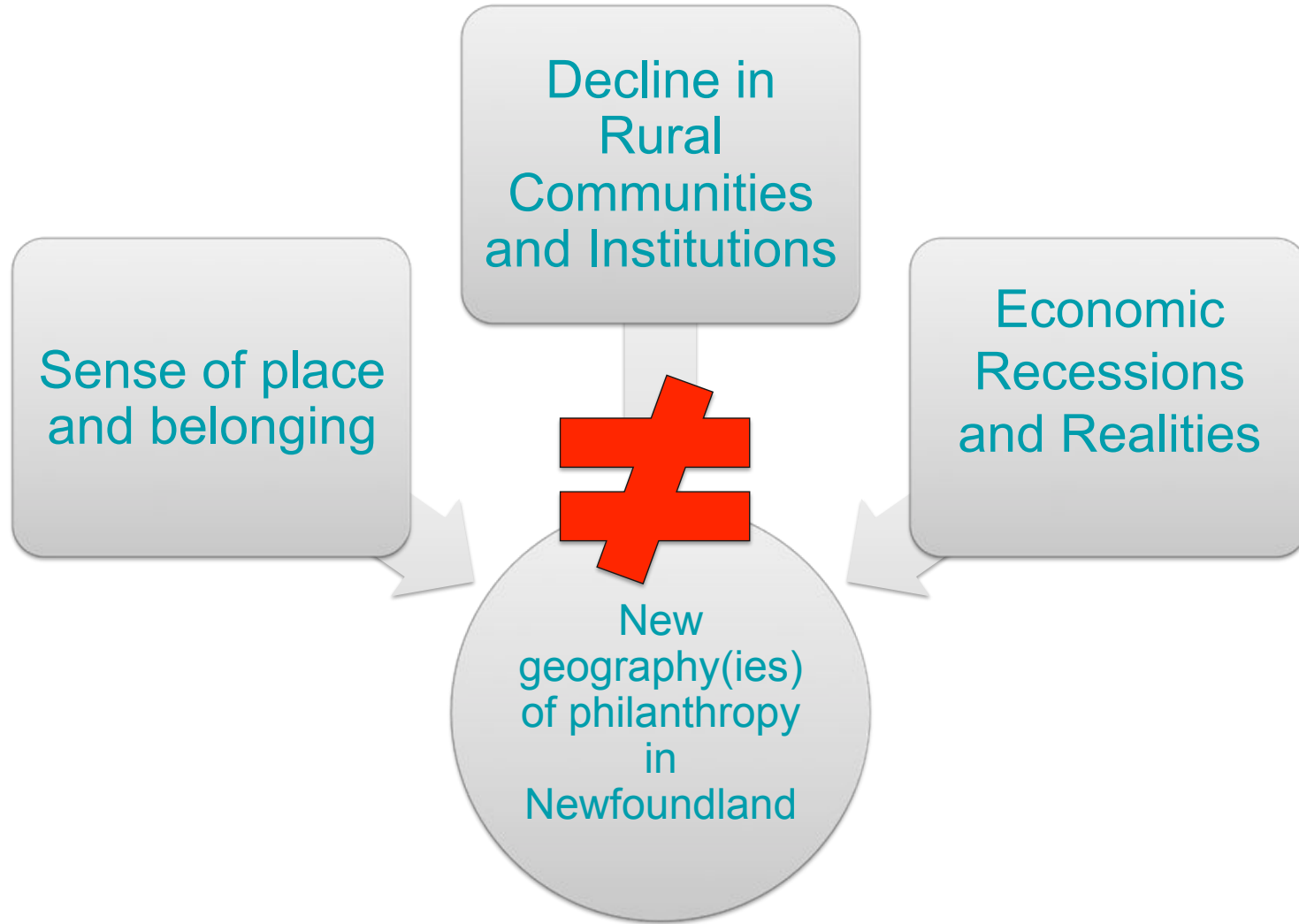


DECLINE OF RURAL AND RURAL INSTITUTIONS

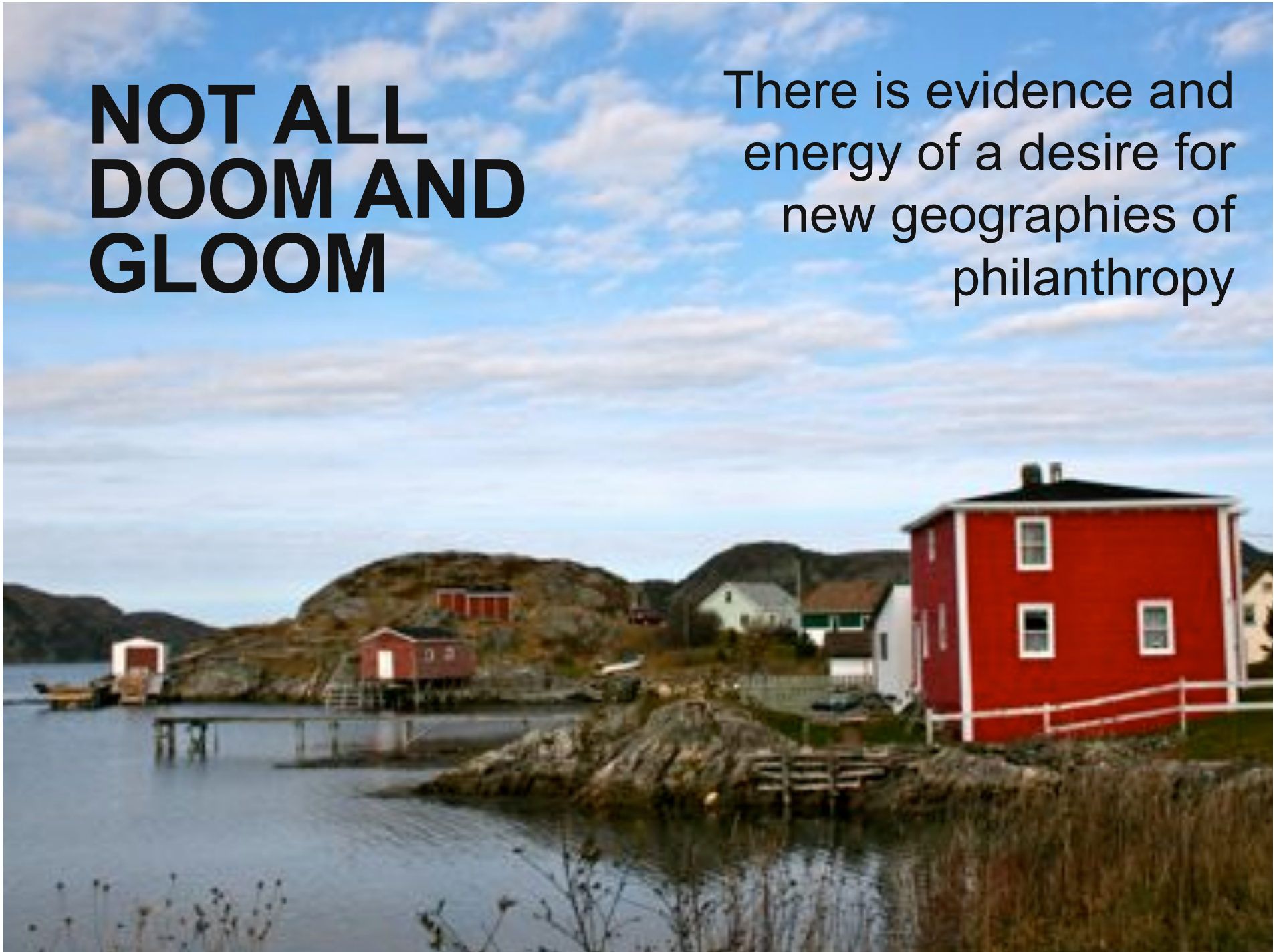
